

Troop 86 Camping Checklist

- Signed Permission Slip – Required, No Slip, No Trip
- Pocketknife – Required, If Qualified and Holding Tot'n Chip
- Personal First Aid Kit – Required, Lightweight, Small-sized Kit
- Matches and Fire Starters – Required, Strike Anywhere Matches in Waterproof Container
- Sun Protection/Sun Screen – Required, Lightweights, Small-sized Container
- Hat of Baseball Style Cap – Required, Something with a Brim
- Signaling Device (Mirror/Whistle) – Required, Loud Whistle, Small Mirror
- Length of Light Cord (50 Feet) – Required, Lightweight Cord, NOT Heavy Rope
- Insect Repellent (Non-Aerosol) – Required, Lightweight, Small-sized Container
- Compass and Map – Required, Map of Current Traveling Area
- Water Bottle – Required, Quart or Litre Size, Hard Plastic, Naglene Type
- Extra Clothing – Required, Think Layers for the Weather, T-Shirt, Hiking Shorts, Sweatshirt
- Rain Gear – Required, Lightweight Plastic Poncho
- Flashlight/Extra Batteries – Required, Lightweight Two AA Size Recommended
- Trail/Camp Food or Snacks – Required, Snacks/Trail food for Hiking
- Camelbak Type of Back Pack/Day Pack – Recommended, Holds ALL of the Above Essentials

The above items are part of the Scout Outdoor Essentials – Page 207 in your Scout Handbook – and are required on ALL hiking/backpacking/camping trips. They should be kept together in your pack, readily accessible for use. You can leave this pack in our Scout Closet.

- Medication – Scoutmaster should carry ALL Medications
- Large Yard Size Trash Bag – Required, 101 Uses, including Picking Up Trash
- Sleeping Bag – Required, Rated to around 35-40 Degrees
- Mess Kit/Silverware – Required, Blue Metal Cup, Plate, Knife, Fork & Spoon OR Spork
- Hiking Boots – Required, Or Study, Comfortable Tennis Shoes
- Personal Items – Required, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Soap, etc.
- Money – Required, \$\$ for Group Food, see Specific Campout Information
- Viper T-Shirt – Required, For Wear during Campout or Hike
- Viper Sweatshirt – Required, It may get Cold at Night
- Scout Uniform Shirt – Required, For Travel to & from Campground or Trailhead
- Scout Handbook – Required, Which Advancement Requirements do You Need?
- Foam or Insulated Sleeping Pad – Recommended for a Better Night's Sleep
- Chair – Recommended, it's Nice to have your OWN Chair
- Bandana – Recommended, 101 Uses on the Trail
- Camera – Optional, Think Photography Merit Badge
- Warm Hat – Recommended for Cold Weather Trips
